Start Campus is the data controller of your personal data in accordance with and pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation - Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 ("GDPR") and Law no. 58/2019, of 8 August – Law on the Implementation of the GDPR in Portugal ("Data Protection Law").

### 4. Cookies

Our website uses Cookies.

Every time you visit our website, you will be prompted to accept or refuse Cookies.

Cookies are small text file that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you visit it. It allows the website to recognise your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions.
